Please note that despite completing this form, you will still need to sign on as per a usual event on arrival.

Race Info

All prize monies listed are subject to a minimum of 16 entries in each class, any less and the fund will be reduced accordingly.

Entries into Pro Street and True Street will be subject to MOT checks at the point of signing on and issued with a tech card. Your tech card must be completed by a member of staff before you begin qualifying.

Rotary entries are welcome in the 6 cylinder class but will not be permitted in the 4 cylinder class.

Electric cars are permitted in any class where they meet the criteria. Road legal electric cars are permitted in the 4 cylinder class.

A helmet and a suitable fire suit is compulsory for all entries, aside from that, the regular RWYB rules apply.

The organisers reserve the right to exclude any entry from their class or the event if they deem necessary. This would only be in the case of a car being deemed unsafe or in breach of their class rules. The organiser's decision is final and no disputes will be entered into.

Field sizes in all classes except Big Bracket (which is all run) are subject to the number of entries that record a qualifying time:

3-6 = 4 car field

7-12 = 8 car field

13-24 = 16 car field

25-50 = 32 car field

51+ = 64 car field

With the exception of the Big Bracket, qualifying will take place on Saturday. There will be no timetabled qualifying sessions. Put in as many passes as you like whenever you like, join the queue and make a pass. Although qualifying will set the fields – ie. The cars qualified for eliminations. Qualifying will not be used to produce a ladder in any class. All elimination pairings, will be drawn from a hat and therefore totally random. This process will also set the lanes to be raced in.

The first or worst disqualification rule will apply to red lights and exceeding track limits as usual.

The Big Bracket

The Big Bracket will be an all run field. The event will be operated with 1 sighting run followed by eliminations. Random pairings will apply until 8 cars remain, at which point they will be paired and offered lane choice based on who was closest to their dial in time in the previous round.
